Gen. 34 - The Dinah Incident in Shechem

I) The rape of Dinah (Gen. 34:1-12)

- Raped by a prince (vv.1, 2)
- The sons of Jacob grieved over the incident (v.7)

- Lawlessness and corruption (vv.8-12)

II) Revenge (Gen. 34:13-31)

- A deceitful plan by the sons of Jacob (v.13)
 - *Our hearts are full of vengeance too (Rom. 12:19)*
 - *We murder each other in our hearts and minds (1 John 3:15)*
- The plan (vv.14-24)
- The revenge (vv.25-31)
 - By the sons of Leah (v.25)
 - The other sons of Jacob involved (vv.27-29)
 - Jacob pronounced an anti-blessing on Simeon and Levi (Gen. 49:5-7)
