Introduction: The picture of a dove in a nest beside a waterfall

Body: Why are we able to be still amid life's tumultuous storms?

- I. God is our <u>strength</u> so we can be courageous (v1-3).
- II. God is our <u>stronghold</u> so we can be glad (v4-7).
- III. God is Lord <u>Sabaoth</u> so we can be at rest (v8-11).

Conclusion:

Sometimes the Lord calms the storm; sometimes he lets the storm rage and calms our soul.
