The Peace that Jesus Brings

Ephesians 2:14-18

Theme: Jesus brings true and lasting peace—peace with God, peace within, and peace with others.

Introduction:

Christmas is a season of peace, but many of us struggle to find it.

1. Jesus Brings Peace Between Us and God (v. 16)

- Sin separates us from God, creating a barrier we cannot remove.
- Through His death on the cross, Jesus reconciles us to God.

2. Jesus Brings Peace to Our Hurting Hearts (v. 14)

- Jesus doesn't just bring peace—He is our peace.
- His peace calms our hearts in the midst of pain, worry, and loss.

3. Jesus Brings Peace Between People (v. 14-15)

- Jesus tears down walls of hostility and unites people.
- The gospel reconciles broken relationships by teaching forgiveness and love.

4. Jesus Offers Peace to All (v. 17-18)

- Jesus came to preach peace to those far from God and those near.
- His invitation to peace is for everyone—no one is excluded.

Conclusion:

- Jesus' birth fulfills the angels' message: "Peace on earth."
- True peace comes through Jesus—peace with God, peace within, and peace with others.

Key Reflection Questions for the Congregation:

- 1. Peace with God: Have you accepted Jesus as your Savior and made peace with God?
- 2. Peace in your heart: What burdens do you need to surrender to Jesus?
- 3. **Peace with others**: Is there someone you need to forgive or reconcile with?
